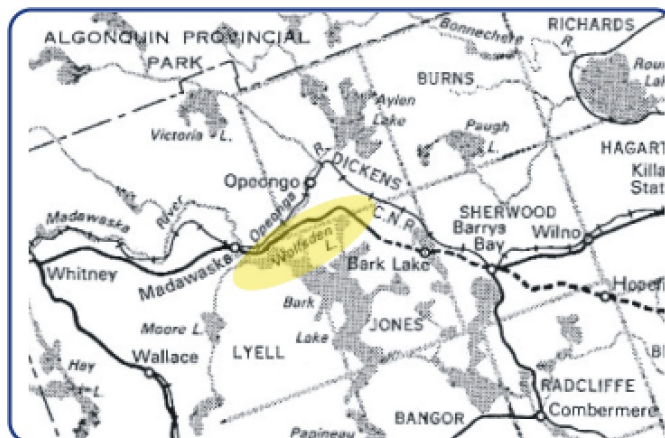


Geographic Note

Wolfsden Lake Becomes Spectacle Lakes

On 22 January 1965 Wolfsden Lake was renamed to Spectacle Lakes. As to what prompted the name change, that has been lost in the mist of time* — a search of the public record has yielded, as this date, no information. The Geological Survey of Canada, Natural Resources Canada, merely records the change of name.

Wolfsden Lake is identified on map below, which was published in 1967 along with an article on the Opeongo Colonization Road.

A lesser body of water along Hwy 60 has been named Wolfsden Lake. Located north side of Hwy 60 about 1.8 km west of junction with Cameron Track road.
